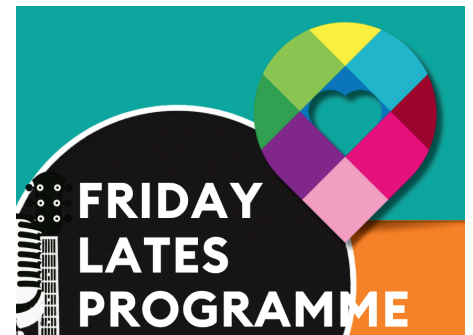


FRIDAY LATES BEGIN

Horsham's CCTV Coverage - Register Yours Today

If your business has private CCTV, you can help Sussex Police respond more quickly and effectively to incidents in Horsham town centre.

Sussex Police maintain the NiCE (National CCTV Database), which allows businesses to register their CCTV coverage details.

Being part of the NiCE register means police can quickly identify camera locations and contact you directly if footage may assist an investigation, reducing the need for officers to make door-to-door inquiries after an incident.

Participation is voluntary, but it plays an important role in supporting safety and partnership working across the town centre.
