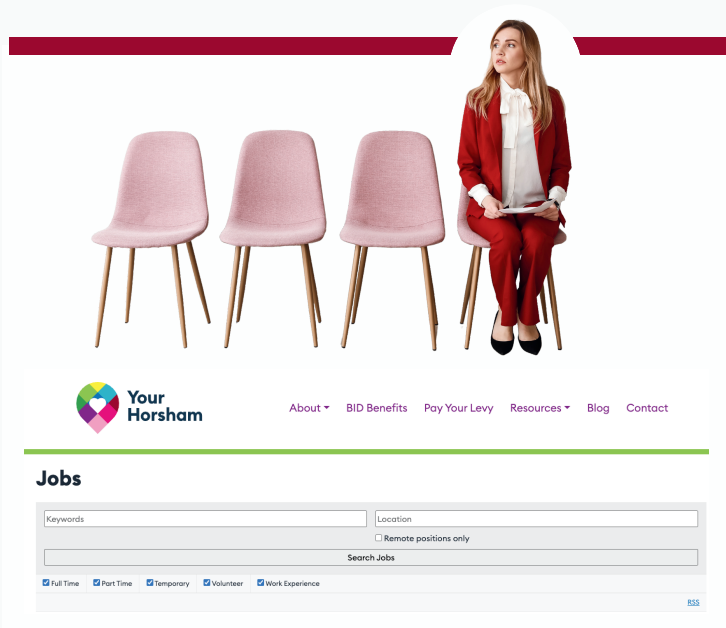

Tell us what you think...

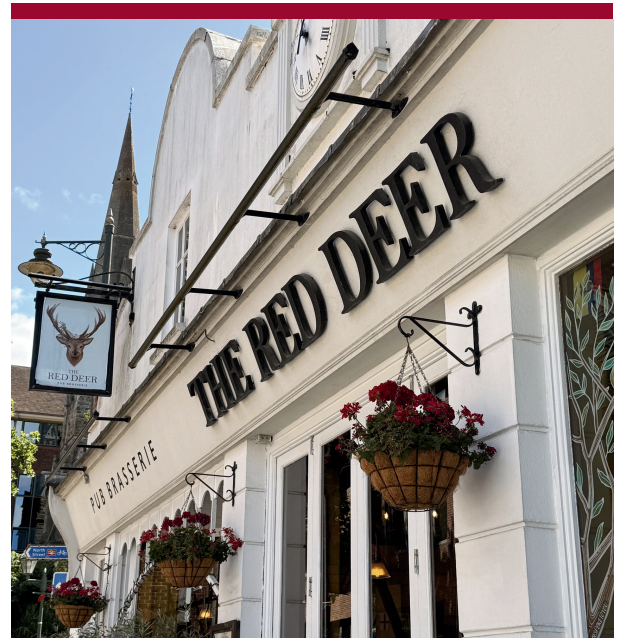
We are always keen to get your views and ideas on how best we can support you, your businesses, and your people.
